ELIGIBILITY:

Eligibility is limited to individuals. No team entries are allowed.

EXPECTATIONS:

Participants are expected to have knowledge of small engine parts, inspection, theory of operation and use of tools.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

Students will have 3 areas they will demonstrate their knowledge in.

1. Theory Test
2. Identification
3. Problem Solving made up of stations using hands on skills and reference material

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Participants are required to be courteous & respectful to others at all times. Interfering with another participant's process or any suspected cheating will be grounds for removal from the competition. Students must also wear their appropriate PPE when competing.

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:

Each participant will provide his or her own Personal Protective Equipment, at minimum, a pair of safety glasses. Gloves and hearing protection may also be worn, if desired.

Each participant should also bring several sharpened pencil.

All other equipment will be provided.

Students not wearing approved personal protective equipment will not be permitted to compete
